

Mystery 2017 – 2018

Step 1

This year we have designed a Mystery that will look excellent in 2 colors, 3 colors, or SCRAPPY! The directions will be written for either 3 colors or Scrappy – if you want to make a 2 color quilt than use the directions for the Scrappy quilt. Without borders the quilt will be 45” 63” – a great size for a throw. Add some borders if you like.

We suggest a very pale neutral for the background color – white or beige would look best. For the other two colors we suggest good contrast. If you are making it scrappy, just make sure that all your fabrics are darker than your background color.

You will need 2 yards for your background, a yard for Color A (this should be your stronger/darker color) and about 1 1/8 yards of Color B. Please note that I have already built in enough fabric for an “oops” or two. If you are going with the scrappy quilt or the 2 color quilt then you will need about 2 yards of fabric.

Pre-cutting

Background fabric

2 strips 3 ½” wide
13 strips 2” wide
16 strips 1 ½” wide

Color A (Darker fabric)

13 strips 2” wide

Color B

11 strips 1 ½” wide
7 strips 3 ½” wide

If you are going to make your quilt scrappy or just 2 colors:

Background cuts are the same as above

2nd color or scraps

8 strips 1 ½” wide
13 strips 2” wide
7 strips 3 ½” wide
